LAET Receives \$500,000 DOJ Grant

KNOXVILLE – Legal Aid of East Tennessee (LAET) has received a \$500,000, three-year grant to expand assistance to victims of domestic violence, dating violence, stalking, sexual assault, and human trafficking. The grant was awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice’s Office on Violence Against Women.

The funding allows LAET to provide comprehensive civil legal services, including legal advocacy, education, and direct representation. Three attorneys and two paralegals will work directly under this grant to help one thousand East Tennessee clients over a three-year period. “There is a critical need for holistic civil legal services in East Tennessee for low-income victims of domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, and stalking,” says Debra House, Associate Director of LAET’s Central and Northern Regions. “LAET and our project partners will continue to expand cooperative efforts in providing services that promote integrity and selfsufficiency, improve victim access to resources, and counsel victims about their options for seeking safety from perpetrator violence.”

Civil legal services will be available to domestic violence victims in any of the twenty-six counties served by LAET.
